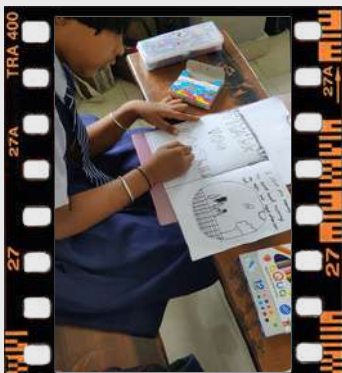


FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM: TRAINING MINDS AND TRANSFORMING LIVES
